Coquitlam Counterbalance Forklift Training - Counterbalance Forklift Training courses are always in high demand. The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift that is designed along with a weight which counters the balance, evenly spreading the load's weight across the forklift arms. Counterbalance forklifts are made so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the operator of the forklift. This particular kind of forklift truck must only be utilized on level, stable ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift drivers are needed to receive training which would allow them to better know the right or proper method across the forklift arms. The trainee will know to correctly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the lift truck mast, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees will be taught the RTITB standards needed for safely operating the forklift. People training would also know the types of attachments for the forklift arms.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into spaces which are small and cramped. This lift is very maneuverable and could access virtually whatever tight space.

Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker is a different forklift that differs somewhat from the Walkie Pallet truck in terms of its lift height. This equipment is designed to access tighter spaces and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. Neither of the Walkie line of lifts can be ridden. The operator has to walk behind them.

Rider Pallet Trucks

The Rider Pallet Truck is made so the operator can ride it. These riding lifts are perfect for dock loading and unloading.

Wave Work Assist Vehicle

The counterbalance forklift referred to as the Wave Work Assist Vehicle can reach heights up to 17 feet.

Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks

The Sit-down Counterbalance Forklift is built in four-wheel and three-wheel forklift designs. These durable and tough trucks are made to be ridden.
