Introduction

General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are usually caused when workers lose their balance or stumble over an item that has not been put away properly. Placing or removing things from storage can result in a fumble or slip, potentially causing both item and employee to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when employees are moving things on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling objects. This is usually caused by failure to properly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting methods are one more common danger.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries could be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, like for example pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, need to be used carefully during loading, packing and unpacking.

Materials that are dangerous, flammable or combustible present one more type of workplace hazard while being stored inside a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around dangerous materials.
