Coquitlam Loader Training - Why You Should Finish A Loader Training Course - Any person who would like to operate a forklift must take a Loader Training program to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are several ways to acquire forklift training. Programs are offered through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved video and on line programs. The price can be minimal (or without charge) when provided through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

In most countries, forklift operators are needed to be over the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies along with federal and local authorities can approve the Loader Training programs. They require that operators acquire lift truck certification before operating a forklift equipment. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Businesses which hire employees to drive lift truck trucks could face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could result in serious injuries and property damage due to incorrect use of the machine. Training includes the proper loading and driving techniques. Employees must pass a written test in order to be certified. A business would normally designate a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new employees. A licensed supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be licensed as a trainer.
